Greetings to all Clan and Society Representatives!

We cordially invite you to participate in our two-day Highland Games, **Sept. 1st and 2rd** (Labor Day weekend), held at the Altamont Fairgrounds, Altamont, NY, about 20 minutes from Albany, New York. Games will be held **RAIN OR SHINE**.

You will be allowed to drive your car in to the clan area between the hours of 7:00 and 9:00 am on Sat. and Sun. This year we recommend you use Gate 1, which is closest to the Clan area. The field will also be open on Friday (Aug. 30th) between 1:00 pm and 4:00 pm. If you arrive after 9:00 am on either day you will have to walk your gear in or we will attempt to access a golf cart to help you move your gear. All cars must be removed from the field before 9:00 am. There will be reserved parking in the general parking area unless you are in possession of a handicap parking pass issued by a state DMV. For those of you who have been with us in past years, please note that the Clans & Societies area will be in the same location as last year at the end of the fairgrounds near the Beer Tent. Please look for signs when you arrive.

The registration fee for Clans and Societies is \$30.00

For this fee, The Capital District Scottish Games will provide:

- 1 Two complimentary tickets for each day and one vehicle pass for both days. (Sunday tickets and passes will be distributed on Saturday).

<u>CAMPING</u>

Camping is available at the Altamont Fairgrounds for Clan/Society representatives, games participants, and the general public. Rates are \$30/night for tent sites and \$40/night for site with electrical and water hook-ups. Please note that sites with electrical and water hook-ups are limited in number so it is recommended that people interested register early. Registration for camping at the Altamont Fairgrounds can be done via the Capital District Scottish Games website, <u>www.scotgames.com</u>.
